Dear Parent, Guardian, Teacher and School Staff:

New York State Education Law Section 409-H and Commissioner's Regulation 155.24, effective July 1, 2001, requires all public schools to maintain a list of parents, guardians, and staff who wish to receive advanced notice from the school of actual pesticide applications.

If you would like to receive 48-hour prior notification of pesticide applications that are scheduled to occur in your school, please complete the form below and return it to Michael Sherman, Director of School Facilities, Mohonasen Central Schools 2072 Curry Rd, Schenectady, NY 12303. The following pesticide applications are <u>not</u> subject to prior notification requirements:

- The application of antimicrobial products.
- The use of aerosol products with a directed spray in containers of 18 fluid ounces or less when used to protect
 individuals from an imminent threat from stinging and biting insects including venomous spiders, bees, wasps, and
 hornets
- The use of non-volatile insect or rodent bait in tamper resistant containers to children.
- The application of a pesticide classified by the US EPA as an exempt material under 40 CFR Part 152.25.
- The use of boric acid and disodium octaborate tetrahydrate;
- The use of horticultural soap and oils that do not contain synthetic pesticides or synergists.
