High School students held a semi-formal dance and the play Little Women was performed by Mohon Masque; at Draper Middle School students who earned high honor roll were rewarded with Dunkin' Donuts and students raised money for disabled veterans; Pinewood students are participating in the Positivity Project where they focus on their character strengths; at Bradt there is a Bradt Giving Tree Initiative to collect snacks for families in need and students are looking forward to the upcoming spirit week.

Matt Ronca Fall Athletics Recognition -Boys' Varsity Soccer Team, Girls' Swim Mr. Ronca reported to the Board on Mohonasen's exceptional fall athletic season. The Boys' Varsity Soccer team went undefeated in the regular season with a record of 17-1 overall. Coach Riley Ford was named Coach of the Year. The girls' Swimming and Diving team

Section 2 Champions and Rachel Miller Section 2 Cross Country Champion excelled as Colonial Council and Division 2 Section 2 Champions, with four swimmers qualifying for the New York State Meet and earning strong state-level finishes. Rachel Miller had an exceptional cross-country season, becoming the Section 2 Class B Champion, placing 16th at the NYS Championship Meet, and breaking records in Winter Indoor Track. These achievements highlight an outstanding season for all teams.

Bradt Elementary School Building Goals -Mrs. Smith The 2024-2025 goals for Bradt School focus on improving academic achievement, attendance, discipline, and professional development. Academic goals aim for a 5% increase in reading and math scores using data-driven and differentiated instruction, parental involvement, and progress monitoring. Attendance initiatives target a 10% reduction in chronic absenteeism through early interventions, incentives, and community support. Discipline efforts focus on reducing referrals by 10% using Positive Behavior Support (PBIS) and restorative practices. Professional development plans emphasize literacy strategies, curriculum alignment, and assessment tools, with structured training sessions and collaborative teacher support.
